- 140. Gribble Ridge Sparkling** **Bottle**
£29.95
Biddenden
A dry sparkling wine bottle fermented by the traditional method. A blend of Reichensteiner, Scheurebe, Pinot Noir and Ortega.
- 131. Pinot Reserve** **£34.95**
Tenterden
Pale gold in colour with pink highlights and an attractive sustained mousse. The nose is rich & complex with hints of redcurrant, strawberry and baked apple on the palate.

Sparkling Rose

- 130. English Rose** **Bottle**

Tenterden
From the colour through to the aftertaste this has delicacy, great finesse & high refreshment value. A light lemon sherbet nose with hints of blackcurrant, rosehip and strawberry on the palate.
- 141. Gribble Ridge Sparkling Rose** **£29.95**
Biddenden
An off-dry sparkling rosé wine, bottle fermented by the traditional method. Produced from single varietal Gamay.

Rose Wine

- 142. Gribble Ridge Rose** **Bottle**

Biddenden
England's cool climate and tough growing conditions help to intensify the flavour of this wine yet contribute to its slightly lower alcohol content. Early bottling has added to the wines fruitiness while a touch of Gamay gives some granite or mineral tones.
- 132. English Rose** **£18.95**
Tenterden
A beautifully balanced dry rosé, crisp strawberry acidity with a swirl of summer fruits, redcurrants and shortbread on the palate.

Made in an unoaked style, clean juicy fruit, steely acidity and a long mineral finish.</i> | £21.95 |

<i>Ripe and inviting characters of nettle, kiwi, gooseberry and pear dominate the nose.
A ripe and punchy style off-dry Bacchus with a rounded and generous fruit driven palate.</i> | £22.95 |

Tenterden
<i>Made from highly aromatic grape varieties Siegerrebe and Ortega with a touch of Bacchus, this wine has a lovely fruity and floral nose of rose petal, lychee and apricots. The palate is clean and fresh, packed full of flavour with seductive sweetness and a long finish.</i> | £19.95 |

KENTISH WINES

Red Wine

- 145. Gribble Ridge Dornfelder** **Bottle**
£17.95
Biddenden
A light summery red wine, an ideal accompaniment to Mediterranean Style Meals. Single varietal wine produced from the Dornfelder grape.
- 137. Trinity** **£21.95**
Tenterden
A blend of Kentish Rondo, Pinot Noir and Pinot Noir Precoce. The nose has plums, brambles, floral notes and hints of cherry and liquorice. Trinity has a soft round palate, smooth tannins, plenty of fruit and a touch of spiciness on the finish.
- 138. Pinot Noir** **£24.95**
Tenterden
Violets, plums, cherries and cranberries on the nose, along with a touch of peppery and earthy complexity. The palate is soft with sweet fruit, fine tannins and a finish that opens up and lingers with all the flavours promised on the nose.

KENTISH BEERS

- Curious Brew Brut 5%** **£3.50**
Brewed using only the highest quality East Anglian Malt and aromatic Cascade and Saaz hops, the beer undergoes a secondary fermentation using specially selected sparkling wine yeast. This process adds complexity, body, aroma and a soft finish on the palate not found in other premium lagers.
- Curious Brew Cobb I.P.A 5.6%** **£3.50**
*Cobb is a Kentish hop variety that is well-known for its aromatic qualities. For this ale the winemaker has selected to use only this single variety of hops in order to capture and preserve its particular characteristics.
IPA, or India Pale Ale signifies that this ale has been brewed in the style of 19th Century British Brewers who made beers that were 'hoppy' and strong enough to withstand the long journey by sea around the Cape of Good Hope to the Indian Empire.*
- Curious Brew Admiral Porter 5%** **£3.50**
This rich, dark Porter has been brewed using crystal, chocolate, black and amber malts from floor malted Sussex barley. The 'bittering' hop is the Sussex grown Admiral, which gives the beer its name. The winemaker's twist is to ferment and condition the beer with oak, giving a delicate balance of sweetness and bitterness, full depth of flavour and creamy vanilla notes.
